North American Inter-District Meetings are comprised of Zonta members across USA and Canada and are held every-other year, opposite our Zonta International Convention. NAIDM25 will be held in Novi, Michigan on June 20-22, 2025, with an expected attendance of between 200 and 300 members.

NAIDM provides multiple educational tracks and keynote speakers to prepare attendees to advance Zonta's mission of making a better world for women and girls. Educational tracks include Developing a Credible and Visible Voice, Club Success, Leadership and Sustainability, and Engagement of Audiences and Allies.
